



Montgomery Bell State Park Golf Pro Shop Dickson, TN



Description of Work:

The old clubhouse at Montgomery Bell State Park was torn down to make room for more than 13,000 square feet in an expanded, brand new clubhouse, pro-shop, and restrooms. The structure consists of structural concrete and wood framing and post tension concrete slab with metal studs. The exterior features stone veneer, hardy board siding, and a metal roof. The expansive covered veranda consists of structural concrete. The new clubhouse features a snack bar, complete commercial kitchen, cart storage space, carpet and VCT flooring, and upgraded mill-work items, such as window and door casings.
